Ms. Brown reported to the Club members on the changes to voting procedures in Michigan resulting from the passage of Proposal 2 in 2022. Among other changes, there will be 9 days of early voting at two voting sites in Waterford prior to the actual election day. All changes will go into effect in 2024.

Ms. Brown also reported on scams in Oakland County targeting the deeds of homes. Some scams are through threatening mailings and others are through identity theft that targets the ownership of homes. The Oakland County Clerk's office has set up a Property Notification Service (free of charge) to help homeowners identify any threats to their property titles.
